RKCB(usualy 4NT bid in agreed suit): 1430 (5 aces); +1 asking Q, than +1 aks for K => bids suit where has K or 2 other kings

PIDO-PIRO: If opp Dbl our RKCB => p=1, Rdbl=0; 5♣=2A w/o Q; 5♦=2A w/Q; if opp bids over our 4NT=> p=1, Dbl=0, 5♣=2A w/o Q, 5♦=2A w Q, SYS ON

Exclusion Blackwood: Ask aces without specific suit, usually with 5th lvl bid

If opp dbl Cue-bid: pass ask for 1st round control => Rdbl=1st round kontrol from both hands, bidding

Lightner DBL (asks partner to give a ruff on first trick)

Slam DBL (in competitive high lvl (slam lvl) auction DBL shows 1 trick, and pass shows 0/2 tricks)
