Style: Light.

DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)

Style: Sound. NV can be light.

Cue bid at level 3- asking for stopper

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE

RESPONSES TO 1 MAJOR: 1NT: 6-9 HCP, 2 other suit = forcing 1

5 card major, Better minor.

1NT: 15-17 (Usually Balanced),
2NT: 20-22 (Usually Balanced).

Weak 2 openings.

SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE

SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES

When Opps X for penalty our 1Nt – Pass is Natural, Rdbl = SOS

Immediately suit = System on, If I bid Pass, my partner bid XX and then I bid suit, I have 2 suits not above.

But if X is not for penalty, we will ignore X.
