

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 /2 Level; Reopening)
1-level= normally 5+ (can be 4+); 2-level=5+ cards; Aggressive style NV;
Overcalls can be light, especially not vulnerable.
If partner overcalls and then I change the overcalled suit - it is Forcing for One Round unless I was already a passed hand.
A cuebid shows constructive support for the overcall. 10+ points.
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2nd/4th Live: Our INT overcall shows 15-18- HCP; Systems On - (For e.g., Stayman, transfers, Multi-Landy still applies)
Reopening: Our INT overcall shows a weaker hand (11–14 HCP); Systems On
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
1-suiter: WEAK
2-suiter: Michaels CUE BID
U2NT shows 5+/5+ in lowest two unbid suits
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Michaels Cue Bids (5+/5+, ANY NV, INT+ VUL)
Jump Cue asks for Stopper
X = Penalty - Shows a hand that wants to defend 1NT (usually 15+ HCP)
2♣ = shows both 5/4 in the majors; 2♦ response asks for better major
2♦ = Represents a single-suited hand - typically a major suit (unspecified).
2♥/2♠ = Indicates a 5cM and a 4-card unspecified minor suit.
2NT: Shows both minor suits (5♣ and 5♦)
*After penalty X of 1N and opps initiate wriggle, next X = takeout and subsequent doubles are for penalty.
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
DBL=MAJORS; 1NT/2NT=MINORS
(1♣) - P - (1♦) - DBL=MAJORS, 1NT=MINORS
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
After 1M – (X) – 2M = 3 card raise; 2N = 4+ cards 10+ HCP; 3M/4M preemptive
After 1m – (X) – 2N shows good raise or better; preemptive raises
RDBL = 10 + (implying no fit and interest in penalty)
